



## COVID-19 Safety Protocols

2021 Festival in the Park (FITP)

Friday, September 24 4 pm - 9pm

Saturday, September 25 11am - 9pm

### **FITP Staff, Concessionaire and Artist Protocols:**

- Tents spaced a minimum of ten feet apart
- Increased setback of artists tents from the sidewalk for wider one-way walkways
- Allow as many open air sides of each 10×10 tent as possible
- Artists will be asked to limit number of patrons in their tents at one time
- Artists will sanitize booth surface area periodically
- Use of masks and gloves encouraged for all
- Use of plexiglass shields at point-of-transaction encouraged

### **FITP Patron Safety Protocols:**

- Stand-alone hand-sanitizing stations will be on site
  - \* Princeton entrance
  - \* Nature Museum Bridge
  - \* Dairy Branch Creek entrance
  - \* Cumberland Avenue entrance
- Sani-can locations as indicated on map
- Staff will be monitoring to ensure that the density of attendees does not get too high for proper 6 ft. social distancing
- Staff will ensure attendee traffic is flowing one-way along paths
- Tables at entrances and foot bridge with staff to explain one-way direction of paths
- Seniors and more vulnerable patrons will be encouraged to shop the early hours and the closing hours of the festival

### **FITP Signs, Barriers and Pavement Markings:**

- Signs in Freedom Park promoting the 3W's (wear, wait, wash) and the N.C. Face Mask Requirement
- Directional signage/arrows at nine (9) locations in Freedom Park including one-way traffic on each side of the path.
- Openings along the walkway will allow for patrons to turn around and walk in opposite direction
- Walking paths would be a minimum of nine (9) feet wide
- Pavement and other markings would provide visual cues for standing 6-feet apart from others while waiting in line
