



2021 Kings Drive Art Walk (KDAW)

COVID-19 Safety Protocols

Saturday, October 30: 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Sunday, October 31: 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

KDAW Staff, Concessionaire and Artist Protocols:

- Tents spaced a minimum of ten feet apart
- Increased setback of artists tents from the sidewalk for wider one-way walkways
- Allow as many open air sides of each 10×10 tent as possible
- Artists will be asked to limit number of patrons in their tents at one time
- Artists will sanitize booth surface area periodically
- Use of masks and gloves encouraged for all
- Use of plexiglass shields at point-of-transaction encouraged

KDAW Patron Safety Protocols:

- Four (4) stand-alone hand-sanitizing stations will be on site
 - * Clock tower entrance at Morehead
 - * Central fountain
 - * Pearl Park Way entrance
 - * Midtown Park
- Sani-can locations as indicated on map
- Staff will be monitoring to ensure that the density of attendees does not get too high for proper 6 ft. social distancing
- Staff will ensure attendee traffic is flowing one-way along paths
- Tables at entrances and foot bridge with staff to explain one-way direction of paths
- Seniors and more vulnerable patrons will be encouraged to shop the early hours and the closing hours of the festival (from 11-12am and after 3:00 pm)

KDAW Signs, Barriers and Pavement Markings:

- Signs on the Greenway promoting the 3W's (wear, wait, wash) and the N.C. Face Mask Requirement
- Directional signage/arrows at nine (9) locations along the Greenway from Morehead to Pearl Park Way including one-way traffic on each side of the path. There will be stanchions/roping dividing the Greenway to allow for one-way walk paths
- Openings along the walkway will allow for patrons to turn around and walk in opposite direction
- Walking paths would be a minimum of twelve (12) feet wide
- Pavement and other markings would provide visual cues for standing 6-feet apart from others while waiting in line
